Single Sign-On for Microsoft IAG 2007

Microsoft IAG 2007 relies on the Kerberos protocol for a Single Sign-On (SSO) user experience. Kerberos is a powerful solution for SSO, but is also considered to be quite complex and costly. For many legacy systems Kerberos is not even an alternative.



PointSharp SSO adds functionality to solve these cases, where Kerberos is not an option or when a quick and fast implementation is needed. The system uses a self learning technique to enable SSO for the users.

PointSharp ID SSO can be used to login users in systems supporting the NTLM, Basic and Form-based authentication methods.
